Encouraged students to reduce plastic pollution and adopt sustainable daily practices. Linked with SDG 12 and SDG 13.



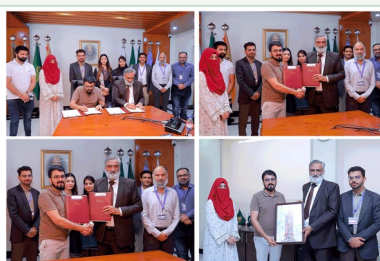

3rd International Symposium on World Food Day

The Department of Nutrition and Dietetics organized the 3rd International Symposium on World Food Day with participation of experts from France, Ireland and Pakistan. The event promoted dialogue on food security, sustainable diets and nutrition innovation.



3rd International Conference on Advanced STEAM Education (ICASE-2025)

ICASE-2025 was organized in hybrid mode with participation from over 15 countries. It promoted global academic cooperation through discussions on technology, arts, social sciences, AI and innovation.



5th International Conference on Dermal Sciences (ICDS 2026)

The conference brought national and international experts together to share developments in wound care, regenerative medicine and dermal sciences, strengthening academic collaboration and knowledge exchange.



International Academic Collaboration at EURIE 2026

The University delegation participated in strategic meetings with leading international universities during EURIE 2026, focusing on academic cooperation, student and faculty exchange and joint research opportunities.

MoU with Cyprus International University

TUF signed a Memorandum of Understanding with Cyprus International University to promote academic exchange, joint research initiatives and collaborative opportunities for students and faculty.



International Workshop on Ethics and Artificial Intelligence in Higher Education

The workshop featured a keynote speaker from Humboldt University of Berlin, Germany, and focused on the ethical use of AI in teaching, learning and research in higher education.



TUF Students International Exchange and Global Academic Exposure

TUF exchange students participated in international academic activities, gaining global exposure and engaging with diverse learning environments that strengthened academic and cross-cultural learning.



MoU with Universiteti European i Tiranes at GETEX

The University signed a Memorandum of Understanding at GETEX in Dubai to strengthen academic collaboration, student and faculty exchange and joint academic initiatives.
