A 2 MW wind turbine is operational, and another new turbine is currently under maintenance.

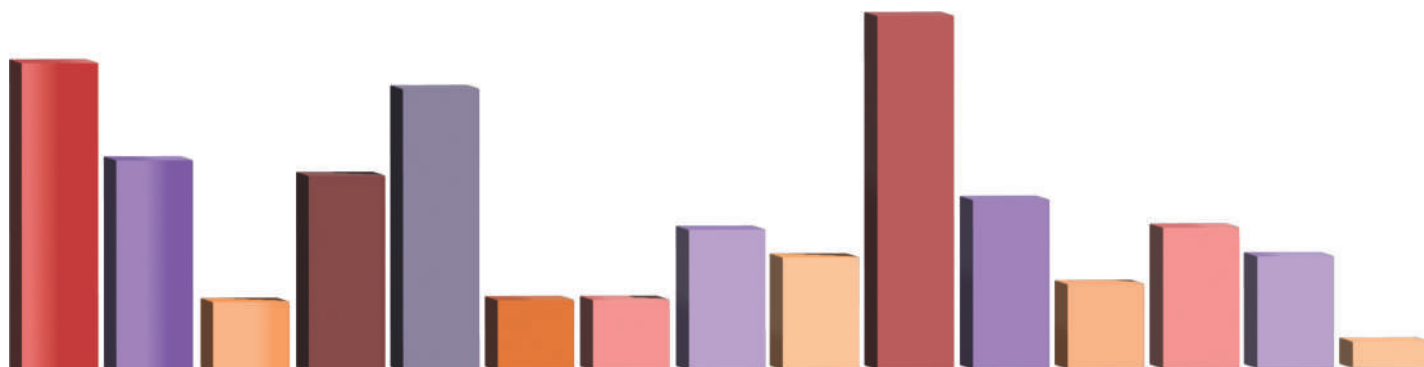

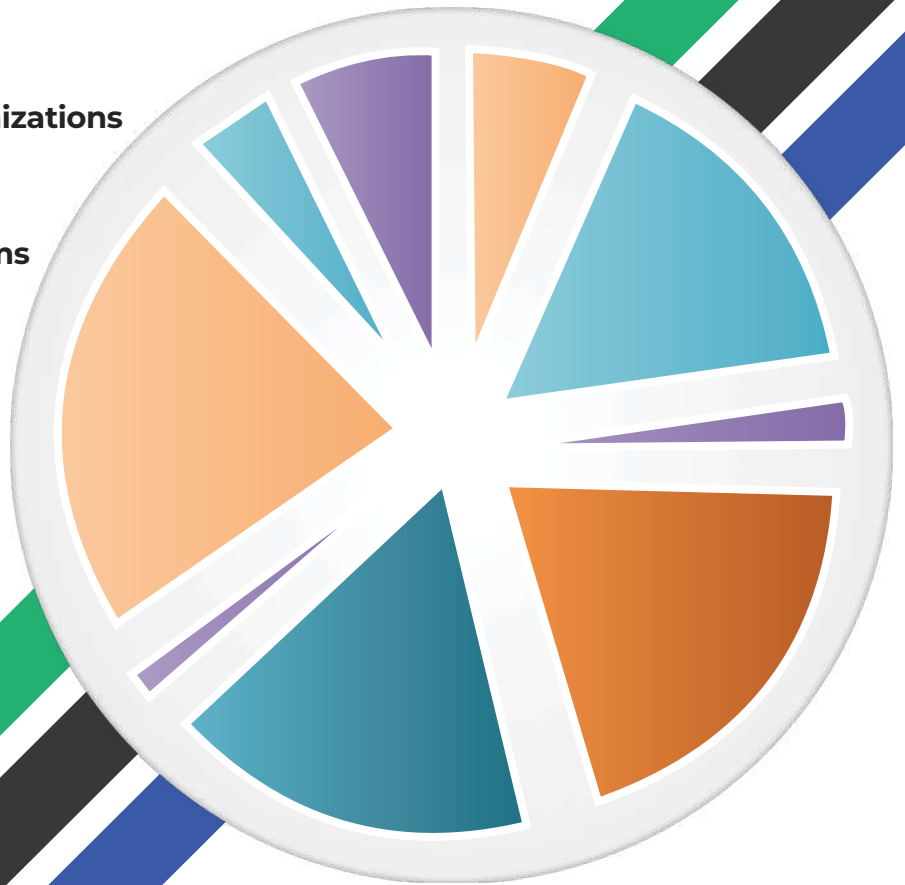

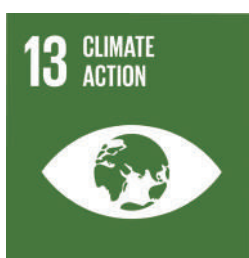


# Research Impact
